<p><b>Buro <i>jan-ZE</i> is a hub of varying form and composition pursuing the question: “how long is a thought.” Through artistic research and art interventions it focuses on the performative dimensions of public places. <a href="http://www.burojanze.nl">www.burojanze.nl</a></b></p> <p><b>Buro <i>jan-ZE</i> was founded in 1999 by the artist Irene Janze</b></p> <p>In the work geological history blends with human history. Earth’s crust, mud, meadows, water and wind are given the same attention as buildings, icons, and waste. The place is stripped bare and built up again out of exotic slices of information. Findings are expressed in installations, drawings, (video) performances, readings, catalogues and workshops. The installations are designed for a certain location or event, from which they draw meaning. In the artworks the location manifests itself as multi-dimensionality, fiction and experiment. They are ‘three-dimensional’ scripts, enabling the ‘reader’ to participate actively in the process of meaning. The artwork constitutes artistic research and enacts theoretical forms of investigation.
